The Board of Directors of The Liu Fang Memorial Scholarship Foundation are pleased to announce the 2026 scholarships for the Foundation. The Board selected two winners of the scholarships for the 2026 - 2027 school year. The Foundation awarded Natalie Lai from Oregon a \$2,000 scholarship to begin her studies at the Cornell University in Material Sciences and Engineering and awarded Lakan Jerke from Indiana a \$2,000 scholarship to begin her studies at the University of Evansville in Engineering. The Foundation Board offers our congratulations and best wishes to these outstanding women as they begin their college journey.

The Board announced 23 April 2027 as the deadline for the 2027-2028 scholarship applications and the Board intends to again award two scholarships for the 2027-2028 school year by 14 June 2027. The Board also announced that scholarships for the 2026-2027 school year will be again be \$2,000 each.

The Liu Fang Memorial Scholarship Foundation is a 501 (c) (3) foundation, dedicated to providing scholarships to women attending a four-year university to major in Physics, Engineering or Mathematics. The foundation was established in memory of Liu Fang, a 1988 graduate of Beidu (Beijing University) with a bachelor's degree in physics, to honor her desire to learn, her curiosity about the world and her love of family.
